YOUR ARRIVAL

When you arrive in the resort, you must first go to the Palais des Sports Paul Olombel (av. Sanguet) to get your parking pass - the day before the race. It must be affixed to the inside windows of your vehicle in order to access the competitors' parking areas.

Schedule of parking pass withdrawal :

Thursday 24 february : 1pm-6pm

Friday 25 february : 9am-12pm & 1pm-5pm

Saturday 26 february : 8am-12pm & 1pm-5pm

Several car parks will be available for you to park on the day of the race or ahead of time for converted vehicles and camper vans. However, they must be vacated once you have finished your race. The car parks will open at 1pm on Thursday 24 February.

P1 : C.H.I - 370 places - only Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais

P2 : Tir à l'Arc - 300 places - only Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais

P3 : Hippodrome - 100 places - Enduropale Juniors et Espoirs (if full, P2)

P4 : Salle des Quatre Saisons - 200 places - Enduro Vintage

P5 : Airport (shuttles will be available to competitors near the parking area on friday and saturday for free) - 170 places for riders of all races who stay outside of le Touquet

Parking Stella Plage for Quads

The day before each race, at the same hour as the technical checks, the vaccinal passes of assistants declared on engage sport will be checked and wristbands handed over in person in a chalet outside the Palais des Sports (no wristbands will be handed over to anybody undeclared previously). Your wristband must be fastened and well secured around your wrist to make sure you'll get to the different areas.

TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

Technical and administrative check will take place at the Palais des Sports Paul Olombel. You must come without your machine at the administrative checks. Once the administrative check has been completed, you will have to collect your machine, affix the stickers, and then go to the technical checks outside the Palais des Sports.

For the administrative checks, you must bring :

- Your **vaccinal pass***
- **ID card or passport.**
- For french competitors, **2022 annual competition licence or one race licence**

■ For non-French competitors, **FIM EUROPE or FIM 2022 licence** issued by their federation of origin accompanied by the «Start Permission» to race at the Enduropale or «one event» licence issued by the FFM. If «one event», you will not need this authorization..

■ **Medical certificate** of aptitude dated **less than one year** for riders taking a «one event» licence, stating that the holder has no «clinical contraindication to the practice of motorbike sport including competition». The originals of all documents must be presented. A template can be downloaded on **www.enduropaledutouquet.fr**

Please note that no exemption will be given for a passage to the administrative and technical checks on the day of the race.

TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Only one accompanying person by competitor is permitted during checks (except for Espoirs riders). Under-18, animals, trots and bicycles are not allowed.

Competitor wristbands will be issued at the administrative checks.

Fire extinguishers are compulsory at the pit stop. Unpredictable checks will be carried out throughout the weekend at the pit stops. Also, for safety reasons, fire extinguishers will not be allowed in the technical and administrative checks.

- For Vintage, Juniors and Espoirs : licence LJA1
- For Motorbikes and Quads : licence LJB1
- For riders competing both the vintage and motorbike races (two races) : LJA2

If you prefer to take your «one event» licence directly on site, the FFM will charge you extra 10 €.

At the end of checks, motorbikes for the sunday race and quads have 30 minutes (45 min max) to go directly at the rider's area. For Vintage, Espoirs and Juniors, motorbikes will be placed into rider's areas on the morning of the race.



RIDERS AREAS AND PIT STOP

Riders areas will be located :

- Enduro vintage, Enduropale Espoirs, Juniors, Quaduro : Parking St Jean 2
- Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais : Place Edouard VII (between church and city hall)

Pit stop will be located :

- Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais, Enduro Vintage, Enduropale Espoirs, Juniors : Parking St Jean 2. Top riders Enduropale : by the second sea front patio.
- Quaduro : Stella Plage sea front

Some rules :

- Competitors must leave the park after their race.
- Tents are not provided; competitors must share a 3m x 3m space. (2 assistants by competitor maximum). For the riders who would have difficulties to find someone to share the space, please let a message on Engage sport "discussion" section
- Once races are over, you must leave the pit stop area on foot, engine off. It is forbidden to take out gear during the race.
- Under-18, animals, trots and bicycles are not allowed in the pit stop area.
- Considering the long distances on site, we advise you to bring your own transport equipment to carry your equipment from the parking area to the pit stop area.

You will find a drop-off point on the «Chalut» car park, close to the pit stop area. CAREFUL, this drop off point is limited to 30 minutes and parking there is strictly forbidden. After 30 minutes, your vehicle will be removed.

Also, only vehicles with a sticker will be able to access this area.

AREAS DEDICATED TO SPECTATORS

There will be areas dedicated to spectators on the beach and the sea front of Le Touquet-Paris-Plage and on the sea front of Stella Plage. Access to the beach between Stella Plage and Le Touquet-Paris-Plage will be strictly forbidden to the public.

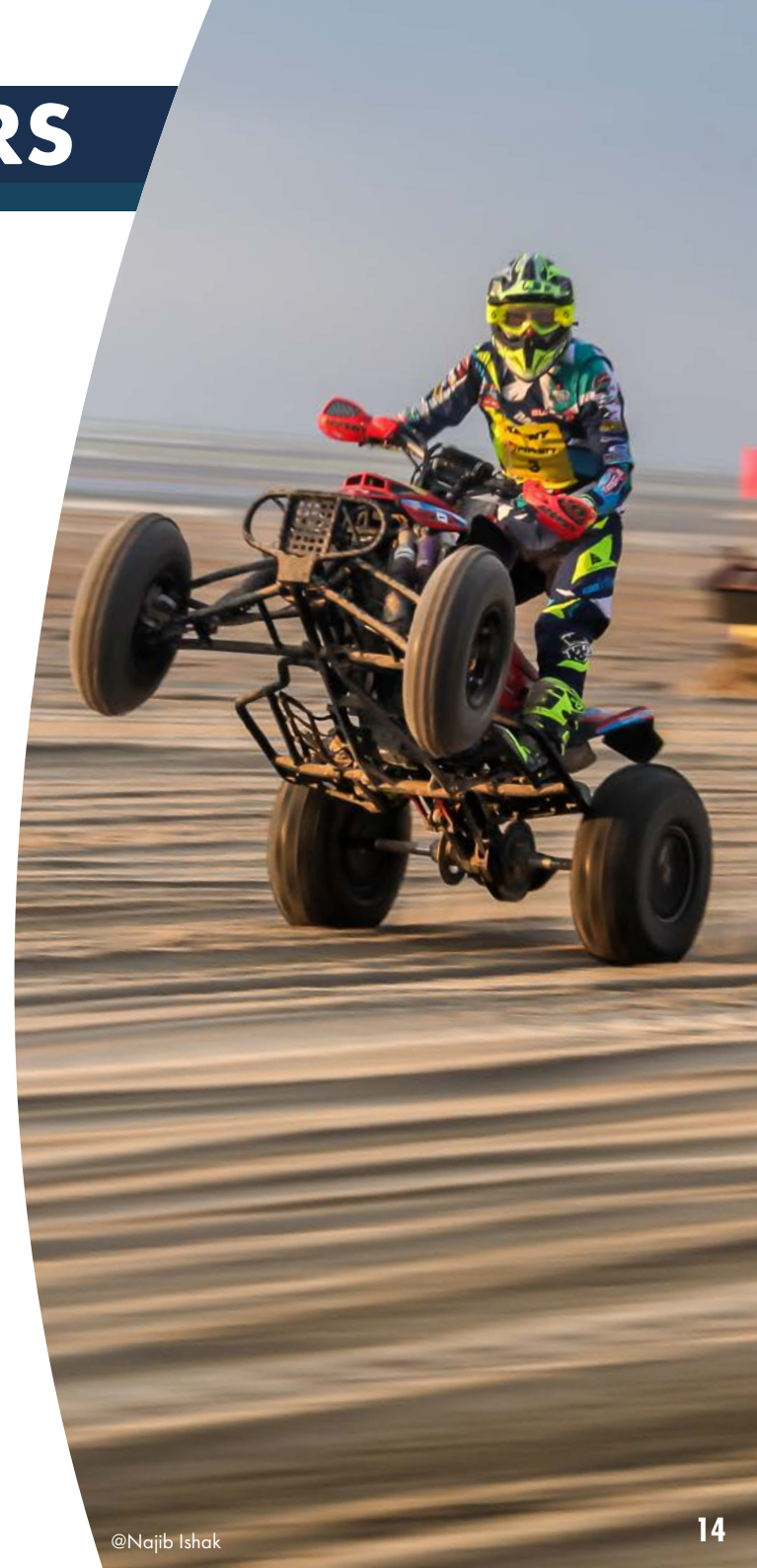
The Enduropale, a major sporting event, will not escape the constraints linked to the security of major events and the applicable health regulations. A large number of police and private security agents will be deployed throughout the town. A network of additional cameras will be installed and will provide a view of all areas that will be frequented by the public 24 hours a day.

We ask everyone to respect the posted municipal orders, the no entry areas and to agree to open your bags during eventual checks. Going inside the dunes and to the bottom of the dunes is strictly forbidden.

Furthermore, identity checks will be carried out during the weekend. Thank you for respecting the instructions so that this great sporting event takes place in the best conditions.

Driving visitors will have to park on the car park of the airport (10€ by car), which is opened on Saturday and Sunday. Free shuttles will take them into town.

Be careful, vaccinal pass is mandatory into the food village.



IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT

The access to the PMA (medical area) is strictly forbidden for families except if accompanied by the organization.

WHERE I CAN GET BACK MY EQUIPMENT LEFT ON THE TRACK :

Motorbikes, clothes and helmets that have been found on the course are brought into the «Parc motos cassés» («broken motorbikes park») located on the car park St Jean 2. :

- Vintage until friday 5pm
- Espoirs until saturday 10:30am
- Juniors until saturday 1pm
- Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais until sunday 6pm

For the Quaduro, the "broken quad bikes park" is located to the **Yacht club of Stella Plage** until saturday 5pm.

Then, from the following Monday you will have to get back your equipment at the technical - avenue Georges Besse - Le Touquet, between 8am and 5pm (from 10am for the Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais). The equipment will be returned to the rider in exchange for the deposit ticket given by the pick-up truck or to the rider's assistance against presentation of an identity document and a photo.

***Competitors are required not to leave their motorcycle or bike quads and equipment on the course until the organisation trucks have collected them. The organisation is not responsible for any theft**

QUADURO

The Quaduro riders will have to join the rider's area in Le Touquet by their own means for the start of the race. No shuttle is planned from Stella Plage (at the end of the race, return to Stella by the beach)

ENTRY TO LE TOUQUET ON SUNDAY

Riders competing the Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais with the wrist band fasted around their wrist and the driver's parking pass givent at the administrative checks stuck on the windscreen of their vehicle will be authorised by the police to enter Le Touquet after 7am on Sunday morning. However, due to the heavy traffic on Sunday, we advise you to arrive in the resort very early to avoid getting stuck in the traffic jam and missing the start of the race.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRACK

Be careful while driving over the second patio, the maximal height is 2m. The organisation cannot be held responsible for the loss of go pro or any other equipment on the circuit during the race.



SOME OTHER VARIOUS POINTS

It is forbidden to drive with your machines on the sea front and in the town under penalty of a fine.

We are expecting from all the riders to communicate the information relating to their assistants on their Engage-sport profile in order to avoid any risk of not having access to the pit stop area.



OUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

Well aware of the current challenges, we have decided to commit ourselves to an eco-responsible approach. This year, we opted for implementing strong measures:

CHARTER OF 15 ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

We will soon sign the new charter of 15 eco-friendly commitments for sporting event organisers established by the Ministry of Sport and the WWF (a charter dedicated to national and international events with a high level of eco-friendly commitment).

SOFT MOBILITY

Implementation of soft mobility for spectators, participants, organisation : incitation to car-sharing, partnership with the Region to allow spectators to take advantage of low-cost TER trains and encourage them to use public transport, organisation of shuttles for the last few km.



OUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

WASTE SORTING

Waste dealing and sorting in the different areas, reduction of waste at the root, limitation of use of plastic in our various processes and paper (reduction of paper printing in favour of digital), essential printing only on recycled and recyclable paper.

BUT ALSO ...

- Making our spectators and participants more aware and more responsible
- Promoting access of disabled persons via the PMR area which is dedicated to them and located on the seafront.
- 20% reduction in organisation vehicles
- Parking area at the airport for traffic easing



YOUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

THE ECO-FRIENDLY RIDER'S CHARTER

As a race competitor, you are committing to:

- Do not drive with any motorised vehicles through the dunes area or on beaches along the whole coastline, except during the race (subject to expulsion from the race for 2 years in addition to penalties further to the official reports made by the competent authorities and the F.F.M.)
- Do not use any tear off helmets and use an environmental carpet at the pit stop
- Not littering but making sure to dispose of packaging in the provided containers and empty water bottles in the recycling bins.
- Using public transport or carpooling to get to the race.
